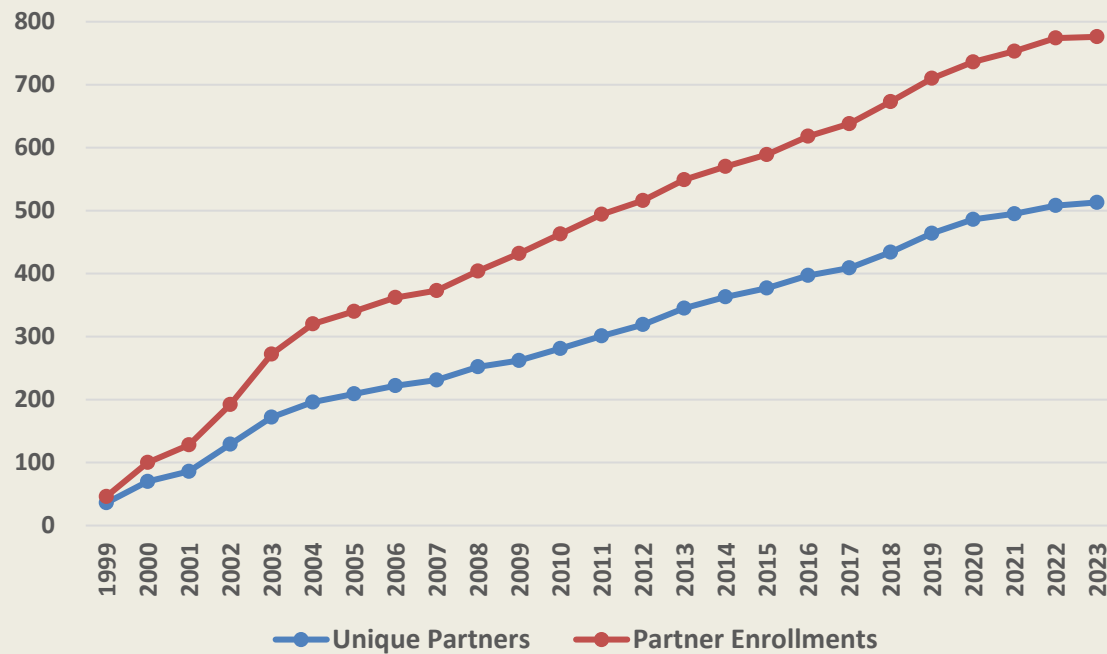

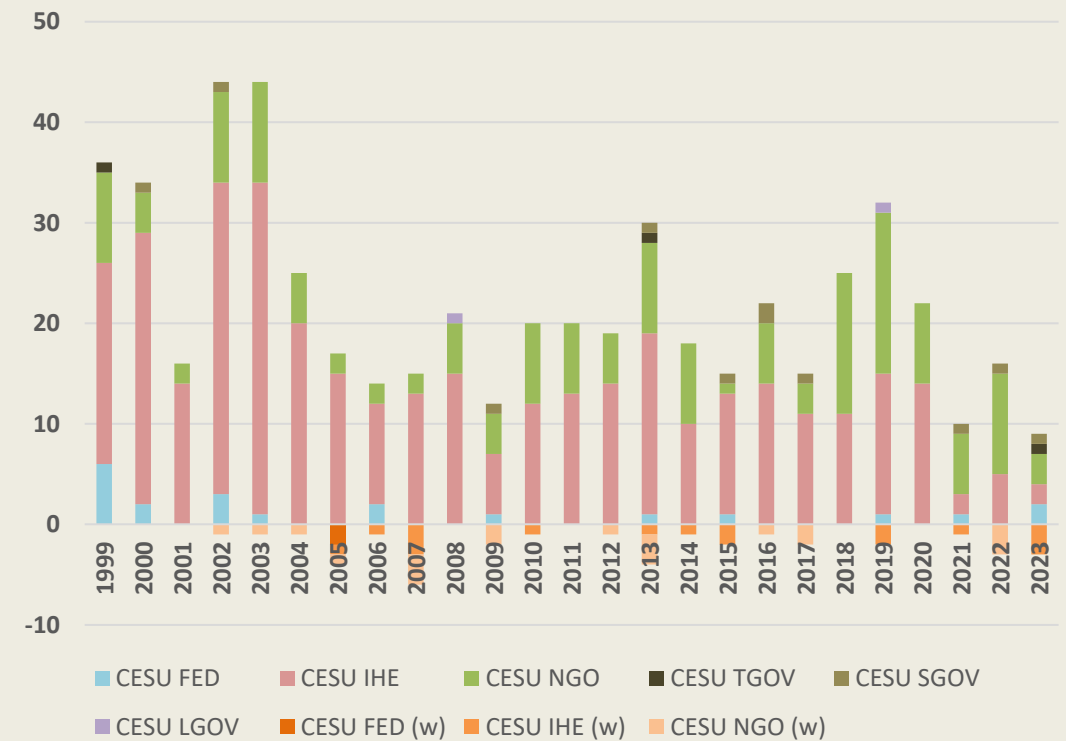

CESU Network CESU Partner Enrollments 1999-present



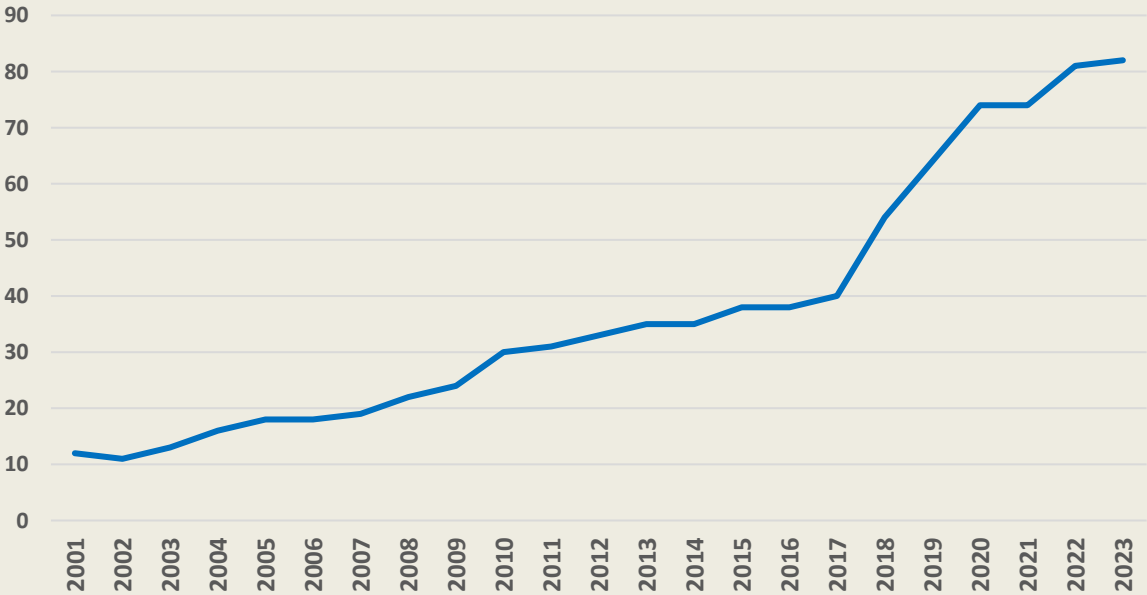
As of JUL 2023...

- Enrollments in CESUs = 780

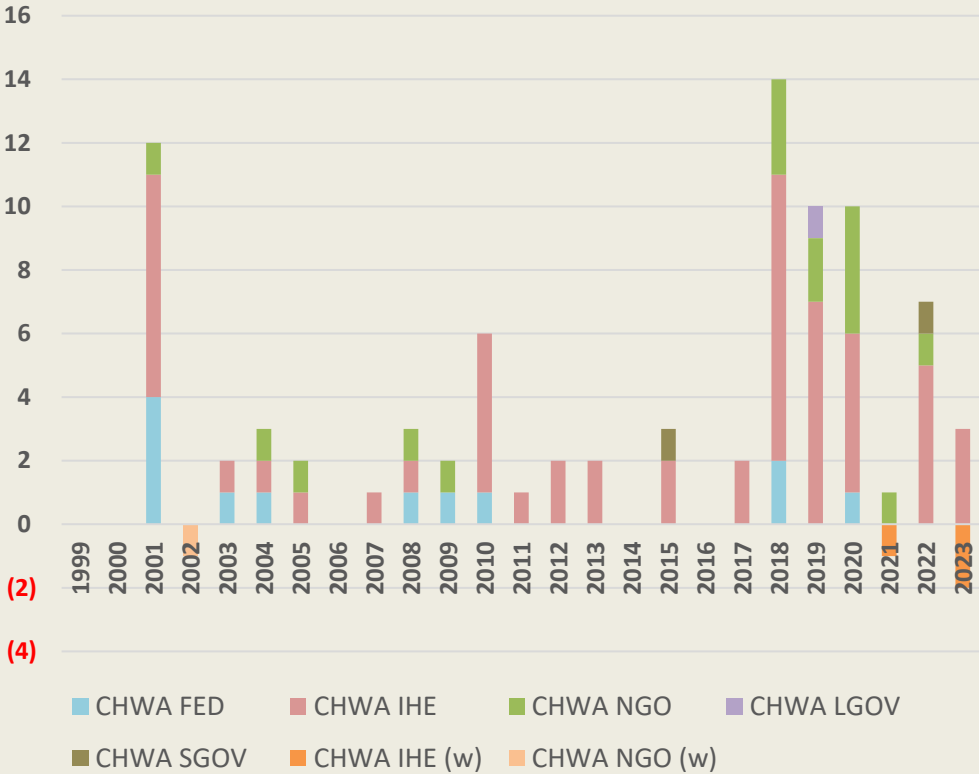
